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

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
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INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Lower exhaust and support as needed to prevent damage.
- 2. Raise hitch into position by aligning the hitch with the (2) existing holes in the frame rails. Using the hitch as a template mark and drill the holes in the rear most position of the hitch, both sides.
- 3. Enlarge access hole in frame rails to allow 7/16-14 carriage bolts and SP11 spacers to pass through.
- 4. Fishwire 7/16-14 X 1 1/4" carriage bolts and SP11 spacers through the enlarged access hole and out the drilled hole and existing hole, both sides. (SEE FISHWIRE TECHNIQUES)
- 5. Reverse fishwire 7/16-14 X 1 1/4" carriage bolt and SP11 spacer in the enlarged access hole, both sides. (SEE REVERSE FISHWIRE TECHNIQUES)
- 6. Raise hitch into position and secure with 7/16" flange nuts.
- 7. Torque all 7/16" hardware to 50 ft-lbs.
- 8. Reinstall exhaust lowered in Step (1).

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.

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
